

Living a Life of Legacy 2 Timothy 4:1-8

In Paul's final benediction to Timothy, we will see what it means to live a life of legacy by making Jesus known to humanity through evangelism and discipleship.

Teach the Saints, Reach the Lost, and Multiply Disciples

I solemnly charge *you* in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: ² preach the word; be ready in season *and* out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction.

For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but *wanting* to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, ⁴ and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths. ⁵ But you, be sober in all things, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry

1. Teach the Saints

2. Reach the Lost

– Jesus is the only one who saves

Matthew 28:19-20: “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

Philippians 1:27- “Only let your manner of life be worthy of the Gospel of Christ, so whether I come and see you, you are standing firm with one spirit and one mind, and not frightened in anything”

– Jesus is worthy of all worship

“ ⁶ For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come. ⁷ I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith; ⁸ in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.”
