## Sermon Reflection Questions

*These questions are designed to help individuals, families, and small groups discuss and apply passages in the Matthew sermon series as taught at Grace Bible Church in Spring 2017.*

### **Observe & Interpret**

Read Matthew 20:1-16. Which of the hired men do you most closely identify with, those hired early or those hired late? Why?

Define the term “grace” in your own words. How is it different than “fair”?

If God treated us fairly, what would we get from Him? See Romans 3:23 and Ephesians 5:5-6.

What is required of us to receive God’s grace? See John 1:12; 3:16; Acts 16:30-31 and Romans 4:4-5.

How would you answer the person who says that offering people God’s grace for free makes it cheap? See 1 Peter 1:18-19 for help.

### **Apply**

List at least five specific examples of God’s grace in your life.

Name three people you know who haven’t yet trusted in Jesus. Spend time praying for opportunities to tell them about Jesus. Pray that they will believe.

**Memorize: Ephesians 2:8-9** For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast.
