Sermon Reflection Questions

These questions are designed to help individuals, families, and small groups discuss and apply passages in the Philippians sermon series as taught at Grace Bible Church in fall 2018.

Observe & Interpret

Read Philippians 1:27-30. List the specific things that the Philippian believers needed to do in order to live "worthy" lives according to this passage.

Distinguish between living "worthy" of the gospel and "earning" the gospel.

Unity within the church is a major theme in this passage. Describe what that unity should look like based on these verses.

List the specific truths Paul shares in verses 28-30 that give us hope and peace when we are persecuted for our allegiance to Jesus.

Apply

Think about each facet of your life, including your behavior, attitudes, words, and relationships. Where are you failing to live "worthy" of the gospel. Be specific.

What attitudes or situations can cause division between you and other believers? What can you do or say to avoid this division?

Memorize: **Philippians 1:27** Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in one spirit, contending as one man for the faith of the gospel
