

## "Here Comes the Sun!" Psalm 19

Perhaps the most profound Psalm on HOW God reveals Himself to us, Tristie shares with us how God shows Himself to the world and the purposes of the Law of God... warning and REWARD!

Psalm 19: HEAVEN, SUN, LAW, REWARD (Think of this in 4 parts!)

Today Let us learn to SEE!!

Observations ...define "See the obvious. How many verses are there?" (We will look at all 3... Observation, Interpretation, Application)

Most important Things to Know

1. General (Natural) Revelation....the sun is illustration!  
\*\*Table talk: The sun!!!
2. Specific (Written) Revelation...the law is illustration!

Pages 44-45 Review Definitions of Observation, Interpretation, Application  
Remember... "Interpretation" is "What does it mean?"

\*Simile, Metonymy, Personification, and Anthropomorphism all used in this Psalm.

Most Important Questions to Understand on Pgs. 45-48

Pg. 45 Question #6 "What benefit is there to knowing God's Word?"

Switch Questions #10 and #9

Understanding the difference between hidden sin and presumptuous (willful/"high-handed") sin.

My interpretation and application of understanding the differences of these "types" of sin is critical.

\*\*Table Talk: How to avoid sin?

1. Worship God as He truly He is in Creation and the Law!
2. Be Clean!
3. Be in the Word! Meditate!

Most Important Application is Memorize Verse 14...it's the point of the whole psalm!

TONIGHT (Alone):

Page 48 What exactly will you do differently this week to apply this principle? Then, what will do these next 3 months to apply this principle?

Go through page 48 and write out your own mission statement of this particular verse.

My Mission Statement is: "I want to worship God through general and written revelation, quickly dealing with sin, obeying His law, and receiving the reward of HIMSELF." TLF 2009

GOD wants to be known!  
What does GOD want to say to you?

"Let the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer!"

1. How many verses are there in the text?
2. How many times is God mentioned in this text?
3. How many times in Jesus mentioned in thus text?
4. Who are the chief characters?
5. What are the key words?
6. What are the direct commands?

There you go! You are on your way!

\*For additional challenge,

1. Where have I seen this same thing (timeless principle in the Old Testament?)
2. What are the verbs in this text?
3. Where is the author writing from?
4. What kind of book is this I am reading? For example, is this a "Prison Epistle" (like Philipians or Colossians) or a "Gospel" like Mark or John?
