## Sermon Reflection Questions

*These questions are designed to help individuals, families, and small groups discuss and apply passages in the Every Knee sermon series as taught at Grace Bible Church in Spring 2018.*

What fears or concerns limit your generosity toward the Great Commission or toward helping those in need?

Do you think it is true that “where your treasure is, there your heart will be also”?

If so, how have you seen this principle reflected in your own life?

In Ezekiel 14:3, the Lord speaks of “idols of the heart.”  
Why do we idolize things in our heart?

What do we expect from these “idols”?

What are the “idols” of your heart?

Take a look at your income and spending this week (if you are married, do this together with your spouse).

If someone who did not know you looked at how you spend your money (or your time), what would they assume about your priorities?

Does this match what you want your priorities to be?

When you think about all that God is doing, both in our community and in the world, and all the ways you could be involved, what ministries, needs, or opportunities excite you most? Why?

Are there ways in which God is calling you to stretch yourself to be more generous?

Why does God stretch us to become more generous?

Theologian Abraham Kuyper said, “There is not a square inch in the whole domain of our human existence over which Christ, who is Sovereign over all, does not cry, Mine!”  
What areas of your life currently don’t belong to Jesus, or prove especially hard to give to Jesus? Why?
