Matthew 6:9–13

“Our Father who is in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.”

James 1:13

Let no one say when he is tempted, “I am being tempted by God”; for God cannot be tempted by evil, and He Himself does not tempt anyone.

God intends our good

Ephesians 3:10

...[the unfathomable riches of Christ have been given to the Church]... so that the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenly places.

Matthew 6:13

...but if You do, deliver us from the
intentions of the Evil One.”

Prayer aligns us with God's will

Matthew 16:18

“...I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it.”

Prayer awakens us to the battle

2 Corinthians 2:11

...[we will not be] outwitted by Satan; for we are not ignorant of his designs.

Prayer awakens us to the battle

- ① the enemy deceives
- ② the enemy divides
- ③ the enemy exploits

Prayer awakens us to the battle

James 4:6–7

But He gives a greater grace. Therefore it says, “God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble.” Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.
