Sermon Reflection Questions

Sermon 14. Acts 20

These questions are designed to help individuals, families, and small groups discuss and apply passages in Acts corresponding to our sermons. Leaders: don't limit yourself to these questions or feel that you need to answer all of them. Pick and choose and create your own based on the needs of your group.

Observe and Interpret

Read 20:17-38. What adjectives would you use to describe Paul's life and ministry as summarized in this passage?

What was Paul's commission from God? What did God call him to do?

Apply

Compare your personal character qualities to the qualities Paul lists of himself. Where do you struggle? What areas of character do you need to focus on this coming month?

What lies are you tempted to believe? How can you guard yourself and other people from these lies?

Think about the three people in your life who don't yet know Jesus that you've been praying for this semester. Brainstorm ideas for sharing the Gospel with them in the next few weeks. Could you send them a card, meet for coffee, study together, serve them in some way...? Be creative.

Memorize: Acts 20:24 But I do not consider my life of any account as dear to myself, so that I may finish my course and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify solemnly of the gospel of the grace of God.
