Sermon Reflection Questions – Creekside

These questions are designed to help individuals, families, and small groups discuss and apply passages in Easter sermon series as taught at Grace Bible Church in spring 2018.

Observe & Interpret

Read John 20 and answer the following:

What evidence convinced Peter and John that Jesus had risen from the dead?

Why was Mary Magdalene weeping outside the empty tomb? Why do you think she didn't recognize Jesus at first?

Why do you think Thomas seemed so reluctant to believe that Jesus had risen from the dead?

What do you learn about Jesus' character from the way He interacts with his friends and followers after the resurrection?

Apply

Do you have any doubts about the resurrection of Jesus? If so, what are they? What would convince you that He is risen?

Practically speaking, how would your life be different today if Jesus had not actually risen from the dead?

Spend some time in prayer and worship giving thanks for Jesus' resurrection. You may find the last five verses of 1 Corinthians 15 particularly inspiring.

Memorize: 1 Corinthians 15:20 But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who are asleep.
