

# PROVERBS 22:6

## Sermon Reflection Questions

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*These questions are designed to help individuals, families, and small groups discuss and apply passages in the (Mis)Understood sermon series as taught at Grace Bible Church in spring 2019.*

### **Observe & Interpret**

**Read** Proverbs 22:6

The first half of this verse could be translated from the Hebrew with the phrase, “Dedicate a youth to his way.” Do you think this is a reference to God’s way, the youth’s own way, or some other way?

Do you think this proverb is intended to be a promise that children who are raised correctly will always grow up to obey God? Why or why not?

Do you think parents bear responsibility for the choices their children make? Why or why not?

In your own words, summarize the meaning of this passage. What does it tell us about how to train our children?

### **Apply**

Write down two prayer requests for each of your children. If you are not a parent, ask somebody in your group how you can pray for their children. Spend some time in your group sharing those requests and praying for them this week.

### **Memorize: Proverbs 22:6**

Train up a child in the way he should go, and even when he is old, he will not depart from it.
