

Jesus, Our Way to Worship

Sermon Reflection Questions

These questions are designed to help individuals, families, and small groups discuss and apply passages in the Behold the Man sermon series as taught at Grace Bible Church in spring 2019.

Observe & Interpret

Read Mark 11:15-18 and John 2:13-17. What was the core issue Jesus that inflamed Jesus' anger? In other words, what exactly was the Jewish leadership doing wrong?

Why did Jesus get so angry about this sin when He was so forgiving and gracious toward other sins? Read also Matthew 6:9 and John 17:4.

Contrast the access to God the Father that the average Gentile (non-Jew) had before Jesus' death to the access we have after Jesus' death. Read also Mark 15:37-38, Ephesians 2:11-18 and Hebrews 10:19-22.

Apply

Jesus wants all people to honor God, His Father with undistracted worship on a regular basis. How are you doing in this area? Are there things you are allowing to distract your time with the Father that you could remove or limit? What exactly can you do this week to increase your undistracted time honoring the Father?

Who do you know that is not yet worshipping God? Have you shared the good news of the gospel with him or her? If so, how did it go? If not, how can you do better? What exactly can you do in the next couple weeks to invite this person to worship the Father through Jesus?

Memorize: Ephesians 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.
