Sermon Reflection Questions

These questions are designed to help individuals, families, and small groups discuss and apply passages in the Behold the Man sermon series as taught at Grace Bible Church in spring 2019.

Observe & Interpret

Read John 13:1-17.

What truths does the passage say empowered Jesus to perform this act of humiliating service? List them.

Why did Peter object to Jesus washing his feet?

Explain the metaphor in verses 8-11. In other words, in v8, what is the spiritual significance of being washed by Jesus? Then, in v10, what is the spiritual significance of a person who is already “clean” having his or her feet cleaned by Jesus?

Apply

What is true of you as a believer in Jesus that can empower and motivate you to follow His example of selfless service? In other words, create your own version of verse 3, listing truths about you.

List at least five specific examples of this foot-washing kind of service in your home, neighborhood, work, or school. In other words, what exactly would it look like for you to serve someone in this manner?

Look back at the list you just created and choose one example you will act upon this week.

Memorize: **John 13:14** If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.
