

JESUS, GIVER OF THE SPIRIT

Sermon Reflection Questions

These questions are designed to help individuals, families, and small groups discuss and apply passages in the Behold the Man sermon series as taught at Grace Bible Church in spring 2019.

Observe & Interpret

Read John 14:15-18,26 and 16:5-15. Why does Jesus call the Holy Spirit our “Helper”? In what ways does He help Jesus’ followers according to these passages?

Read John 3:1-8, Ephesians 2:1-5, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Titus 3:5-6, and 1 Peter 1:3-4. What does it mean when Jesus says we must be “born again” to enter His kingdom? What specifically has the Spirit done in the lives of those who have been born again? What is required of us to be born again?

Read Galatians 5:16-23 and Philippians 2:12-13. What does the Spirit desire to do in your life, and what is your role in that process?

Apply

Re-read Galatians 5:22-23 and reflect on your own life in the last few months. Have you seen this fruit of the Spirit in your attitudes, words, and deeds? Have you grown in any of these areas? Have you struggled in any of these areas?

What exactly can you do this week to make yourself more available to the Holy Spirit to work in your life?

Spend a few minutes thanking God that He has not left you alone, but has instead given you His Holy Spirit.

Memorize: Galatians 5:22–23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control...
