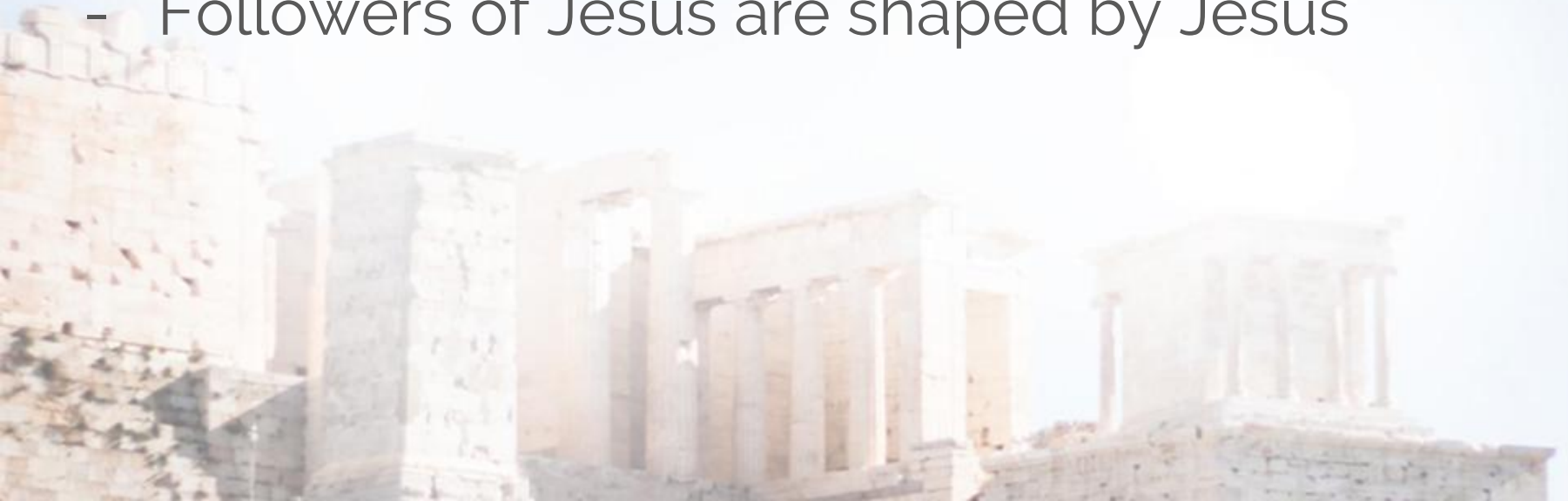

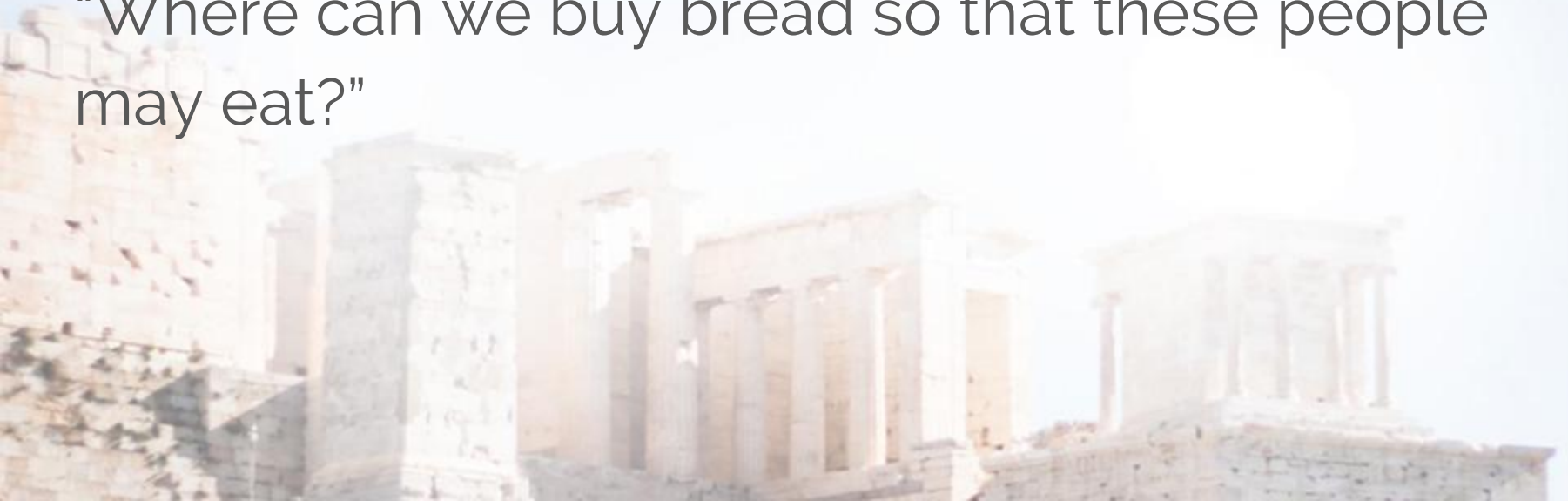
Philip

(Now Jesus said this to test him, for he knew what he was going to do.)



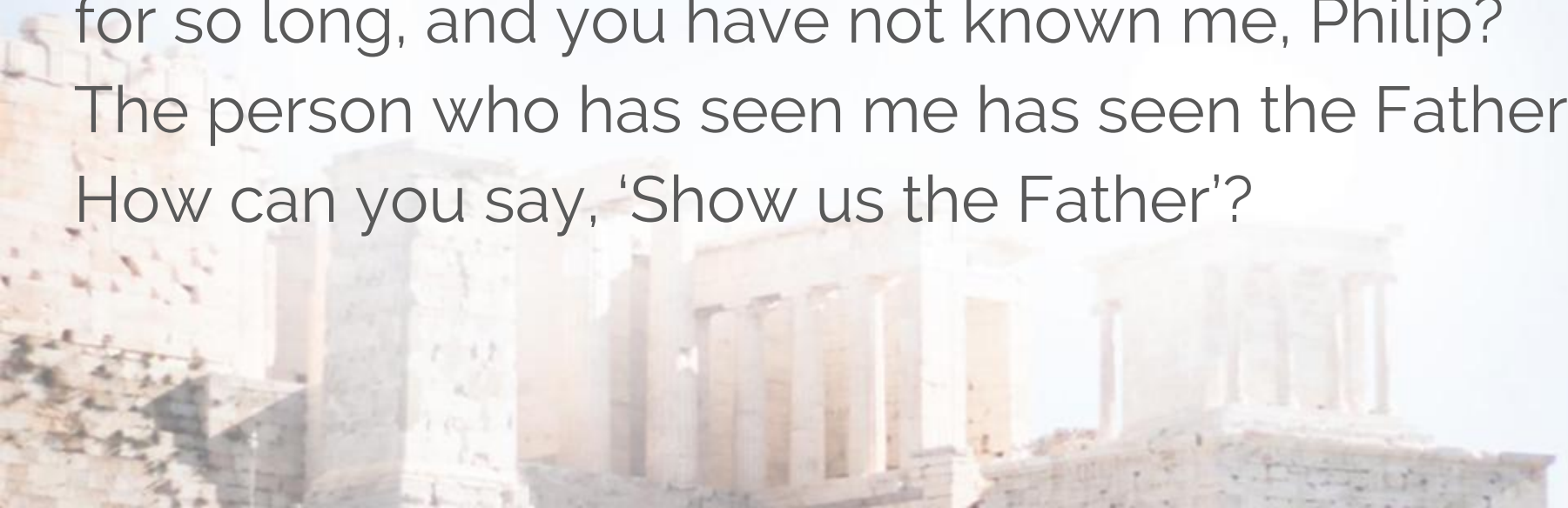
John 6:7
