to "MISS"

- <sup>1</sup> And you were dead in your trespasses and sins,...
- ~Ephesians 2:1

to "TRESPASS" or "VIOLATE"

A sin is ANYTHING we do, say, or think that misses or violates God's perfect standard.

- <sup>8</sup> But sin, taking opportunity through the commandment, produced in me coveting of every kind...
- ~Romans 7:8
- <sup>17</sup> So now, no longer am I the one doing it, but **sin which dwells in me**.
- ~Romans 7:17

Sin is the powerful force within our very nature bent toward rebellion against God.



<sup>19</sup> For as through the **one man's disobedience the many** were made sinners, even so through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous.




