
Judges/Kings Covenant with David

#### Prophets in the Old Testament timeline...





Jeremiah's words speak into all circumstances, especially difficulties

Difficulties from evil or brokenness in the world

Difficulties from our own bad or sinful choices

Difficulties caused by others' actions toward us (their choices)

Difficulties that cannot be explained (accidents, illnesses, etc.)
