For even as the body is one and *yet* has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ.

13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit...

But God has so composed the body, giving more abundant honor to that member which lacked, 25 so that there may be **no division** in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another. 26 And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it. 27 Now you are Christ's body, and individually members of it.

#### Watermark Survey Results

- 82% Study the Bible five to seven days a week
- 177% Consistently apply Scripture to daily circumstances
