





# The one deficiency of the Abrahamic Covenant: it didn't give Israel a <u>WAY TO ACCESS</u> the blessings

The <u>RULES</u> Israel had to follow to enjoy <u>ABRAHAMIC COV BLESSINGS</u> in their lifetime

NOT about <u>HEAVEN OR HELL</u> because salvation is always by <u>FAITH ALONE</u>

#### DEUTERONOMY 24:14-15

You shall not oppress a hired servant who is poor and needy, whether he is one of your countrymen or one of your aliens who is in your land in your towns. You shall give him his wages on his day before the sun sets...

#### DEUTERONOMY 5:7-21

...Honor your father and your mother... You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not steal. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. You shall not covet...

No – only Israel before the cross




# Problem with the Law: told them what to do but didn't give them the <u>DESIRE</u> to do it


#### **DEUTERONOMY 5:29**

'Oh that they had such a <u>heart</u> in them, that they would fear Me and keep all My commandments always, that it may be well with them and with their sons forever!'

Saul: a man after <u>THEIR OWN</u> heart David: a man after GOD'S OWN heart



#### Davidic Covenant is like the ABRAHAMIC

It promises David: <u>HOUSE</u> (descendants)

THRONE (authority)

KINGDOM (nation to rule)



# Davidic Covenant was IRREVOCABLE But to experience its promises David's descendants must OBEY THE LAW

#### Why did God take the throne from Saul but not David?

# 1 SAMUEL 13:11-12

But Samuel said, "What have you done?" And Saul said, "Because I saw that the people were scattering from me, and that you did not come within the appointed days, and that the Philistines were assembling at Michmash...

# 1 SAMUEL 13:11-12

...therefore I said, 'Now the Philistines will come down against me at Gilgal, and I have not asked the favor of the Lord.' So I forced myself and offered the burnt offering."

### PSALM 51:1-4

Be gracious to me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness; according to the greatness of Your compassion blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin...


### PSALM 51:1-4


...For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. Against You, You only, I have sinned and done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are justified when You speak and blameless when You judge.

# The New Covenant REPLACES the Old (Mosaic) Covenant



"I will vindicate the holiness of My great name which has been profaned among the nations, which you have profaned in their midst...



... "Then the nations will know that I am the Lord," declares the Lord God, "when I prove Myself holy among you in their sight. For I will take you from the nations, gather you from all the lands and bring you into your own land...

... "Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you...

... "and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances...

#### EZEKIEL 36:23-30

... "You will live in the land that I gave to your forefathers; so you will be My people, and I will be your God. Moreover, I will save you from all your uncleanness; and I will call for the grain and multiply it, and I will not bring a famine on you...

#### EZEKIEL 36:23-30

... "I will multiply the fruit of the tree and the produce of the field, so that you will not receive again the disgrace of famine among the nations."

Spiritual promises of the New Covenant:

FORGIVENESS of sins
A new HEART (desire to obey)

His SPIRIT will live in them



Physical promises of the New Covenant:
Israel and Judah returned and reunited
Prosperity
Fertility, peace, safety



### The New Covenant is <u>HOW</u> God will fulfill all of His covenant promises to Israel

It's what gets humanity back to the garden!

## Difference between the New Covenant and the other covenants: It did not BEGIN YET



"For behold, the day is coming, burning like a furnace; and all the arrogant and every evildoer will be chaff; and the day that is coming will set them ablaze," says the Lord of hosts...

... "But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings; and you will go forth and skip about like calves from the stall. You will tread down the wicked..."


... "Remember the law of Moses My servant, even the statutes and ordinances which I commanded him in Horeb for all Israel...
